



## CIRCLE AMERICA JOURNEYS

After introduction of preliminary operations, extensive service will begin with the 'American Traveler' train set traveling on Circle America Journeys that visit the four corners of the United States, normally boarding on Saturdays for eight days and seven nights. Journeys can be enjoyed by boarding or leaving the train at various Amtrak stations. Frequent extended stopovers at en-route destinations allow passengers to enjoy a variety of recreational and other attractions. Journey routes follow:

- Journey 1 - San Antonio to Chicago <sup>(1)</sup>
- Journey 2 - Chicago, Seattle, to Vancouver
- Journey 3 - Vancouver, Reno, to Los Angeles
- Journey 4 - Los Angeles, the Grand Canyon, to Chicago
- Journey 5 - Chicago, Niagara Falls and Toronto, to Washington
- Journey 6 - Washington, Tampa, to Miami
- Journey 7 - Miami to San Antonio <sup>(2)</sup>

<sup>(1)</sup> Journey 1 departs on Monday and is for 6 days and 5 nights.

<sup>(2)</sup> Journey 7 depends on the reopening of Amtrak service, which was closed because of hurricane damage to a railroad bridge that has been repaired.

Additional Train Sets including the American Explorer, Adventurer, Voyager, Trekker and Discoverer will follow on different itineraries throughout the USA and into Canada.

Service on regional routes will offer shorter Journeys and Private Cars will travel as part of Train Sets or by themselves as part of Amtrak and other trains.
